The PUD was offered a temporary solution to trash collection for the Flying L Community. Republic Services offered up to 12 months, on a month-to-month basis; to continue the same service as we currently have. The PUD is under no contract with RS after May 29th and can cancel the service, giving RS a 30-day notice.

The cost will remain the same for the community during that time frame, whether it be for the full 12-months or shorter.

Our contract with Republic Services ends on May 29, 2026. The POA Board agrees, starting May 30, 2026; they will be totally responsible for keeping the property clean and they will issue any fines that they discover and can be proved. Those fines will be given to Yancey by the 10th of each month so that they can be processed.

If the PUD sees any accumulation of items on the ground or lids left open that would allow blowing trash or buzzards that will create a mess and it's not cleaned up in a timely manner, a warning will be issued to the POA Board. If multiple warnings are given that will be grounds to terminate the dumpster service agreement. If we get an upcharge for overfilling any dumpster you will be responsible for the overage cost.

If the POA wants to stop being responsible for the dumpsters, they will need to give us a 60-day notice during which time they will still be responsible for the dumpster maintenance.

If our merger with Yancey is completed before the 12 months that is when we will cancel our service agreement with a 60-day notice with Republic Services. The choices at that time will be, if Yancey wants to utilize the PUD property and allow the dumpsters to stay, the POA Board will need to establish a contract with RS as the PUD's will be cancelled.

If Yancey has no need for the property and structure, the PUD may offer the building and property to the POA. (This option has not yet been discussed or decided on by our Board.)

If the POA Board accepts this agreement, service will continue as outlined above.
